ENTRIES

The application for participation can be submitted by an individual person, club or the team captain who represents the specific Ski Association and the athlete. The registration must take place no later than 10th of May 12.00.

Registration after deadline (10th of May 12.00) is possible only with double entry fees, if it is free places.

ENTRY FEES

Entry fee of 20 EUR per racer per discipline will be charged.

Lift tickets 15 EUR per Race day for racer and 10 EUR for coach.

The entry fee has to be paid to the organizing committee at the race office before BIB.

INSURANCE

RACE EQUIPMENT

Races for U8; U10 and Snowboard will use semi gates.

Races for U12; U14; U16; Elite and Master Groups will use SL gates (27 mm) and GS panels. Elite and Masters will share the same course with U12; U14; U16 racers.
