### ENTRIES

The application for participation can be submitted by online registration in link: [REGISTRACIJA, LIST OF PARTICIPANTS](#). The registration must take place no later than 7<sup>th</sup> of February 14.00 hours. After registration deadline it is possible participate only if organizer have place and with double entry fee.

### ENTRY FEES

Entry fee of 20, - euro per racer per discipline will be charged.

Lift tickets 15 euro per racer per day will be charged,

The entry fee has to be paid to the organizing committee at the race office before the TCM of the respective race. Team captains will be asked to confirm their entries and pay the entry fee at the race office before the TCM.

Race Office will work in Snow Arena 8<sup>th</sup> of February 17.00 - 19.00.

### Race EQUIPMENT

Races for U12; U14; U16, Elite and Masters will use SL gates (27 mm) for SL race. Races for U8; U10, OPEN will use semi gates for SL RUN. Elite and Masters will share the same course with U12; U14; U16 racers. OPEN group can ski with skis or snowboards.

The Lithuania Cup competitors are divided into the following age groups.
