FIS group. Men - **M21** and Women - **W21** (born from 2005 and older. A competitor must have reached his 16th birthday before the end of the calendar year);

All **FIS** athletes participate in one Men - **M21** and one Women - **W21** group (a competitor must have reached his 16th birthday before the end of the calendar year (1st January – 31st December) in which the season ends (not younger than born in 2004)). Athletes from all countries can participate in the competitions. All FIS athletes must have a **valid insurance and valid FIS code**.

Competition course:

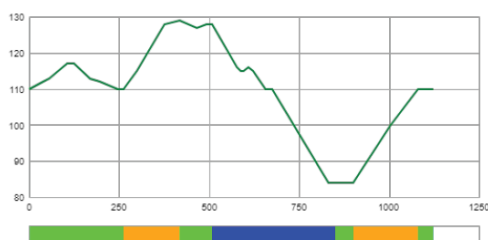
Competition course will be inside the Snow arena building.

Lap length 1,1 kilometers.

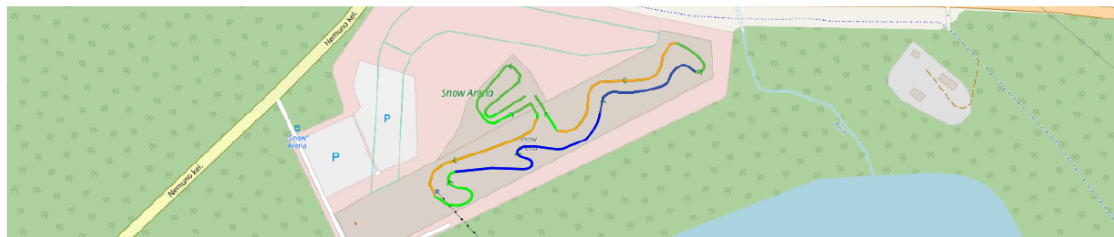
Competition will be in Free and Classic techniques.
